The University Place Security will confiscate any food or beverage sold without their previous authorization or the Health Department. You can sell sodas, water and juices on the food booth. The sale of Guaraná (any brand) and Limonada is to be sold by the Festival only.

- 1) The following is an agreement between _____ and The Utah Brazilian Festival organizing committee/Viva Brazil Cultural Center. The contract is not valid until the application is completed, signed and paid in full. Application must be emailed by **June 30, 2019** and you can donate online at www.UtahBrazilianFestival.com. Please send a picture of the signed contract via Email: info@vivabrazilcc.org or Text: 801-427-0607. Payment can also be done via Venmo @VivaBrazil. If paying with check please call for arrangements.
- 2) You should bring a 10X10 pop up tent (any color), tables and chairs as needed. Exhibitors are responsible for their own set up, cleanup of their area and removal of all personal items after the event. Please bring your own garbage can. **Tents must be anchored with sandbags or other kind of weights to be safe due to wind gusts (like cement blocks, buckets with water, etc).**
- 3) **Electricity: Food vendors should bring their own generator.** Electricity at the Mall is limited. If you need any kind of electricity bring your own generator. It can be rented at Events Rental Places like Diamond Rental or Home Depot/ACE.
- 4) The event officially runs from 1 to 7pm. Set up can start Friday evening (Sep 13) starting at 9pm. (due to the Market Place that runs from 4 to 9pm at the Mall). You also have the option to bring your equipment before 3pm. On the 14th vendor can arrive early at your convenience. Vendors must be ready by 12pm when the University Place will close the access to cars to the Festival area. You can start selling/presenting to the public any time before 1pm until 7pm.
- 5) Promotion and Sale of Merchandise: Vendor agrees to exhibit and/or sell only those items listed on Vendor's application, which have been approved by the Committee. The Committee makes every effort to prevent multiple vendors from undermining each other by selling the same items, including but not limited to quantity of products to be sold by each vendor. Vendor understands that it is the Committee's exclusive right and responsibility to remove any items that are different from the content, style or quality of the works described on the application, or otherwise not in compliance with the Utah Brazilian Festival or University Mall rules or policies, or which are late, controversial, unlawful, politically oriented, or otherwise inconsistent with the quality, message, purposes or values of the Festival.
